

## LICENSE TO CARRY FIREARM

## **APPLICATIONS:**

- 1. Fill out the application in full using **SP 4-127**.
- 2. Bring the application in person to the Sheriff's Office M-F between 9 and 3:30, excl. holidays.
- 3. Do not sign the application until you are in the presence of a clerk in the sheriff's office. \*

## \*In person application will require two visits to the Sheriff's Office

- 4. You can apply online at <u>https://delawarepa.permitium.com/ccw/start</u> **follow instructions**. Note that for online applications there is a \$5 dollar convenience fee only one visit required.
  - <u>A valid government issued photo ID is mandatory</u>. A valid photo driver's license, or photo identification card (not expired or suspended); voter registration or vehicle registration card; military identification card; tax bill to determine residency. Note that owning property in Delaware County DOES NOT necessarily establish residency in Pennsylvania.
- 6. Non-citizens: In addition to the identification requirements above, if you are a non-U.S. citizen you must provide a valid government issued document which shows your immigration status. The most common documents are an alien registration card which has an AR number, or a Form I-94 which will have an eleven-digit admission number.
- Bring \$20.00 in cash, or a money order. The sheriff's office does not accept checks or cards.
  RENEWALS: Same as above. Check RENEWAL at top right of application.
  - You may apply up to 2 months prior to your expiration date.
  - You will be notified by mail as to your approval, or denial within 45 days of submitting your application.
