

If someone is in immediate danger (e.g., suicidal), call 911.

For voluntary inpatient care, contact a social worker, psychiatrist, or therapist, or visit the Stabilization-Triage-Assessment Referral Program at 2200 Providence Ave. in Chester, PA.

Call the Mobile Crisis Team at 1–855–889–7827 for all other cases. They can assess the situation by phone or in person. If involuntary admission is needed, they will complete and submit a petition to the County Delegate for approval.

Once approved, police transport the individual to the nearest emergency department for evaluation and possible admission (up to 5 days).

The Delaware County Office of Mental Health will follow up with petitioners and explain next steps, including the 303 hearing if extended care is needed.
