**Delaware County Offers Assistance for Residents Affected by Recent Floods**  
*Three Locations set up for residents to apply for federal financial relief*

Delaware County Emergency Management has coordinated relief efforts with local municipalities to open Individual Assistance Centers to residents affected by severe flooding in our area earlier this month. Residents of Darby Borough, Radnor and Upper Darby were among the hardest hit areas during the storm and flooding on Aug. 13. Delaware County reminds residents impacted by the recent flooding that the deadline for reporting damage is approaching. To assist residents who have not yet reported their damages to PEMA, Delaware County has partnered with Darby Borough, Radnor Township and Upper Darby Township to operate local individual assistance reporting centers on Aug. 31 and Sept. 1. The centers can assist residents with reporting damages and connect residents with volunteer service agencies offering additional assistance.
