## NOTICE

This Notice is being issued by the Delaware County Board of Elections, pursuant to the recount order issued by the Secretary of State Leigh M. Chapman to all Boards of Elections in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Notice is hereby given that the Delaware County Board of Elections will conduct a recount of votes cast at the May 17, 2022 Republican Primary for the office of U.S. Senator.

Notice is further given that this recount will commence with Logic & Accuracy testing of tabulation equipment at 1:00 p.m. on May 31, 2022. Recounting and recanvassing of the Republican ballots will begin at 8:30 a.m. on June 1, 2022. The goal is to conclude the recount before the statutory deadline of June 7. Both the Logic & Accuracy testing and the recount of the Republican ballots will occur at the Union Power Plant ("Wharf facility"), 2501 Seaport Drive, Suite BH120, in Chester, Pennsylvania. Starting June 1, 2022, the recount work will be performed from 8:30 a.m. through 4:30 p.m., and hours may be extended if necessary to meet the statutory deadline.

By law, this recount notice and a separate recount plan are being supplied to the affected campaigns and Republican Party leaders. This notice also is being published on the Delaware County Board of Elections' web site under Candidate Resources.
