How It Works: A simple assessment helps determine your needs, matching you with available housing solutions.

*If you or someone you know is homeless, the Delaware County Coordinated Entry System is the gateway to County-funded emergency shelters. Just 3 easy steps!*

Get a Coordinated Assessment Service to review your housing situation.

Speak with an assessor to determine your next steps towards stable housing.
