

LEGAL NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Delaware County Board of Elections on Monday August 31, 2026 at 9:00 a.m., will conduct a random roll of the dice to select the precincts that will encompass the hash testing for the November 3, 2026 General Election. Hash testing of the software of the selected voting equipment will then commence Tuesday, September 1, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. at the Voting Machine Warehouse, 403 East 24th Street, Chester, PA 19013. Testing of all of the central servers and central-count equipment will commence at 1 p.m. on Sept. 1 at the Union Power Plant, Room BH120, 2501 Seaport Dr., Chester PA 19013. Any person properly credentialed as a certified civic group, watcher or authorized representative may be present during the testing. Hash testing is a best practice for the election authority to match the software fingerprint on the local equipment against the software fingerprint that was issued by the state and federal authorities that certified the voting system. Hash testing has only one passing score: a 100% perfect match.
