Unofficial Notice of Election for Military and Overseas Voters County of DELAWARE General Election November 3, 2026

This is an Unofficial notice of the General Election to be conducted on November 3, 2026, in Delaware County. You may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA), available at www.fvap.gov/uploads/FVAP/Forms/fpca.pdf. You may apply for an absentee ballot by submitting your FPCA by email to uocava@co.delaware.pa.us

You may request an absentee ballot from this office at any time prior to a Primary or Election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, you are also entitled to vote using the Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot (FWAB) available at www.fvap.gov/uploads/FVAP/Forms/fwab.pdf. Military electors may also use the FWAB to register to vote and vote simultaneously.

You may use the FWAB to vote for candidates for **all** federal, state and local offices, and ballot initiatives.

To vote, fill out and send in the **Voter Information Page** (FWAB page 2) and **Official Backup Ballot** (FWAB page 3).

- To vote for federal, state and local offices or for ballot initiatives – write the names of candidates or the ballot initiative in the appropriate section of the FWAB.
 - Under the **Federal Offices** heading, enter the name and political party of the federal candidate you choose.
 - Under the **Other Offices** heading, enter the state or local office, name of candidate, and political party of the candidate you choose.
 - Under the **Ballot Initiative or other items** heading, enter the title of the ballot initiative (referendum) you are voting on and write “yes” or “no.”

SENATOR IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY – 8th Senatorial District (Vote for One)

District shall consist of Part of DELAWARE COUNTY consisting of the Townships of Darby, Tinicum and the BOROUGHs of Collingdale, Colwyn, Darby, Folcroft, Norwood, Sharon Hill, and Yeadon.

SENATOR IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY – 26^h Senatorial District (Vote for One)

District shall consist of Part of DELAWARE COUNTY consisting of the of the TOWNSHIPS of Upper Darby, Marple, Newtown, Upper Providence, Ridley and Springfield and the BOROUGHs of Aldan, Clifton Heights, East Lansdowne, Glenolden, Lansdowne, Media, Millbourne, Morton, Prospect Park, Ridley Park, Rutledge and Swarthmore

REPRESENTATIVE IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY – 159th Legislative District (Vote for One)

District shall consist of Part of DELAWARE County consisting of the CITY of Chester and the TOWNSHIPS of Lower Chichester and Upper Chichester and the BOROUGHs of Eddystone, Marcus Hook, Parkside, and Trainer.

REPRESENTATIVE IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY – 160th Legislative District (Vote for One)

District shall consist of Part of DELAWARE COUNTY consisting of the TOWNSHIPS of Bethel, Chadds Ford, Concord and Thornbury and the BOROUGH of Chester Heights.

REPRESENTATIVE IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY – 161st Legislative District (Vote for One)

District shall consist of Part of DELAWARE COUNTY consisting of the TOWNSHIPS of Aston, Chester, Middletown District 1 and District 2, Precincts 1 and 2, Nether Providence, Ridley Wards 2 and 7, and Precincts 1-1 and 5-1, and the BOROUGHs of Brookhaven, Rose Valley and Upland.

REPRESENTATIVE IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY – 162nd Legislative District (Vote for One)

District shall consist of Part of DELAWARE COUNTY consisting of the TOWNSHIPS of Darby Wards 1 and 2 and Ridley Wards 3, 4, 6, 8 and 9 and Precincts 1-2, and 5-2, and the BOROUGHs of Folcroft, Glenolden, Norwood, Prospect Park, Ridley Park, Rutledge and Sharon Hill.

REPRESENTATIVE IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY – 163rd Legislative District (Vote for One)

District shall consist of Part of DELAWARE County consisting of the TOWNSHIPS of Darby Wards 3, 4 and 5 and Upper Darby Districts 1 and 2, District 3 Precincts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9 and 10 and District 5, Precincts 4, 6, 8 and 9 and the BOROUGHs of Aldan, Clifton Heights and Collingdale.

REPRESENTATIVE IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY – 164th Legislative District (Vote for One)

District shall consist of Part of DELAWARE County consisting of the TOWNSHIP of Upper Darby, District 3, Precincts 6 and 7, District 4, District 5, Precincts 1, 2, 3, 5, 7 and 10, Districts 6 and 7 and the BOROUGHs of East Lansdowne, Lansdowne and Millbourne.

REPRESENTATIVE IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY – 165th Legislative District (Vote for One)

District shall consist of Part of DELAWARE County consisting of the TOWNSHIPS of Marple Wards 5, 6 and 7, and Precinct 4-2, Springfield and Upper Providence and the BOROUGHs of Media, Morton, and Swarthmore.

REPRESENTATIVE IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY – 166th Legislative District (Vote for One)

District shall consist of Part of DELAWARE County consisting of the TOWNSHIPS of Haverford and Marple Wards 1, 2, 3 and Ward 4 Precincts 1 and 3.

REPRESENTATIVE IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY – 168th Legislative District (Vote for One)

District shall consist of Part of DELAWARE COUNTY consisting of the TOWNSHIPS of Edgmont, Middletown Districts 2 Precinct 3 and Districts 3 and 4, Newtown and Radnor.

REPRESENTATIVE IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY – 185th Legislative District (Vote for One)

District shall consist of Part of DELAWARE COUNTY consisting of the TOWNSHIP of Tinicum and the BOROUGH of Colwyn.

REPRESENTATIVE IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY – 191st Legislative District (Vote for One)

District shall consist of Part of DELAWARE COUNTY consisting of the BOROUGHs of Darby and Yeadon.

REFERENDUM

THE FOLLOWING QUESTION SHALL BE VOTED UPON IN DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA:

Shall debt in the maximum principal amount of up to \$120 million be authorized for purposes of financing land conservation, including protecting drinking water sources, water quality in rivers and creeks, wildlife habitat, conserving trees to protect air quality, conserving wetlands to prevent flooding, providing greenways and parks, protecting natural areas from development, and related costs, to be incurred by the County as debt approved by the voters, requiring public disclosure and annual independent audits?
