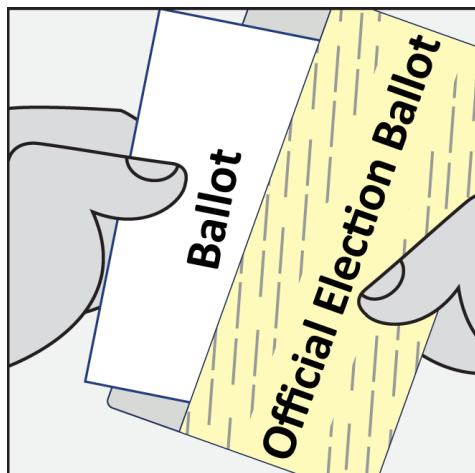
Remember:

- DO NOT drop a ballot-return envelope in a box that is for library books or paying bills.
- Never use another county's ballot Drop Box to return your ballot.
- Return only your own envelope.
- **Anyone assisting a disabled voter must obtain a signed Designated Agent form.**

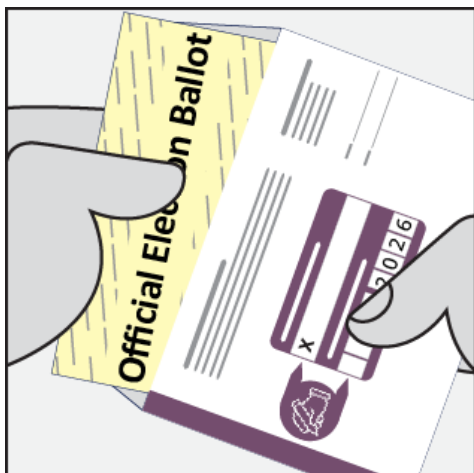

Instructions—Make your ballot count!



1. Put your ballot in the yellow envelope that says **“Official Election Ballot”** and seal it.



2. Put the yellow envelope that says **“Official Election Ballot”** in the **return envelope with the purple coloring.**



3. Sign and date the return envelope. **Put today's date**—the date you are signing.



Return your ballot right away. Your ballot must be received by your county Board of Elections by 8 p.m. on November 3, 2026. Track your ballot at <https://vote.pa.gov/mailballotstatus>.

- ✓ **You must return your ballot yourself, at a County Drop Box – or by mail.** If you have a disability that prevents you from returning your ballot yourself, contact us at the phone number below.
- ✓ **If you lose your ballot or make a mistake,** contact us at the phone number below.
- ✓ **If you return your voted mail ballot by 8 p.m. on Election Day,** you cannot vote in-person at your polling place.
 - **If you bring your mail ballot and purple return envelope to your polling place,** you can vote in-person at your polling place.
 - **If you do not bring your mail ballot and return envelope to your polling place,** you can vote only a provisional ballot at your polling place.
