Focus Community: Upper Darby

Upper Darby is one of the nation's most diverse communities, with more than 60 languages spoken. The 69th Street Terminal, a major transportation hub, draws an unhoused population, including individuals living with substance use disorders and mental health challenges. Other heath concerns in the area include high rates of uninsured people; a need for culturally-appropriate care; and limited access to nearby healthcare facilities, mental health services, harm reduction, and chronic disease management.
