Rules Governing the Conduct of Party & Campaign Authorized Representatives for Observing Ballot Processing

Under penalties of removal from the ballot processing location(s) and/or perjury, the undersigned hereby swears or affirms the following:

1. Representatives submitted necessary paperwork at least four days in advance of Election Day.
2. One representative of a campaign or political party may attend at any time.
3. Photography, videotaping, and all other recording is strictly prohibited. Additionally, representatives may not possess or use any recording devices in the ballot-processing locations or bring any bags, purses, backpacks, cell phones, laptops, cameras, binoculars, or any other devices that could be used to: (a) view ballots or votes; (b) record or capture images of ballots, or (c) observe operator passwords.
4. The representative shall not disturb or disrupt personnel conducting pre-canvassing or canvassing. All questions, comments, and/or concerns shall be addressed to the designated manager.
5. The representative shall stay in the designated areas for representatives and not interfere with staff. This includes not making abusive comments to staff.
6. The representative shall adhere to other reasonable rules of conduct, as circumstances may warrant, established by the manager.
7. Representatives who are removed will not be allowed to return or to be substituted.
