DELAWARE COUNTY DA TANNER ROUSE ANNOUNCES CHARGES AGAINST MAN WHO THREATENED SHERIFF SIDDIQ KAMARA

Media, PA – Delaware County District Attorney Tanner Rouse announces that charges have been approved against Sean Keenan, 40, of Havertown, PA for the threatening voicemails left for Sheriff Siddiq Kamara. A comprehensive investigation was led by Detective Ed Rosen of the Delaware County Criminal Investigation Division and Deputy District Attorney Douglas Rhoads.

According to the Detective Rosen, on July 18, 2026, the Delaware County Sheriff's office received two voicemails. The first voicemail left by the defendant stated, "Death to Islam" and "I will find you, I know where you are, you're an amateur, you sold your tell, I will find you, I will break you" was received at 11:12 PM. A second voicemail was received at 11:15 PM stating "Death to Islam, I'm going to find you n----r I'm going to hunt you, I'm going to hunt you like I go hunting in Alaska, I'm going to find your trail, and I'm going to snipe you when you least expect it and I'm going to force feed you your intestines" followed by laughter. Further findings found that in addition to these voicemails, multiple calls were made by the defendant from his personal and work phones.

"The words used in the voicemails to Sheriff Kamara were vile, disgusting, and completely unacceptable. There is a time when language crosses the line into criminal behavior and that is exactly what we have here. Threats of violence, most especially racially motivated violence,

have no place in Delaware County, regardless of who the intended victim may be. Every threat is taken seriously, thoroughly investigated, and those responsible will be held accountable. I want to thank Det. Rosen and DDA Rhoads for their quick work making sure this individual was identified and arrested.” said District Attorney Tanner Rouse.

Sean Keenan was charged with the following:

Terroristic Threats W/ Intent to Terrorize Another (F3) – 1 count

Ethnic Intimidation (F3) – 1 count

Harrassment (M3) -- 1 count

Disorderly Conduct – Obscene Language/Gestures -- 1 count

On July 28, 2026, a complaint was filed against Sean Keenan and an arrest warrant was issued. He was arrested, arraigned, and bail was set to \$100k unsecured with electronic home monitoring. There is a preliminary hearing set for August 7, 2026, at 9 AM. The investigation remains ongoing. The District Attorney’s Office urges anyone with additional information to contact the lead investigator on this case, Detective Ed Rosen at 610-891-4161.

The District Attorney and the Criminal Investigations Division would like to remind everyone that all individuals charged are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
