

**Official Notice of Election
for Military and Overseas Voters
County of DELAWARE
2022 General Election (November 8, 2022)**

This is an official notice of the general election to be conducted on Nov. 8 2022 in DELAWARE County. Qualified voters may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA), available at www.vote.pa.gov or www.fvap.gov. Qualified voters may apply for an absentee ballot by submitting an FPCA by fax to (610) 892-0641, or by email to UOCAVA@CO.DELAWARE.PA.US

Instructions

- FPCA voters may request an absentee ballot at any time prior to a primary or general election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, FPCA voters also may vote using the Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot (FWAB).
- You may use the FWAB to vote for candidates for all federal, state, and local offices, and ballot initiatives.
- To vote, fill out and send in the **Voter Information Page** (page 2) and **Official Backup Ballot** (page 3) of the FWAB.
 - To vote for federal, state, and local offices or for ballot initiatives – write the names of candidates or the ballot initiative in the appropriate section of the FWAB.
 - Under the **Federal Offices** heading, enter the name or party of the federal candidate you choose.
 - Under the **Other Offices** heading, enter the state or local office, and name or party of the candidate you choose.
 - Under the **Ballot Initiative or other items** heading, enter the title of the ballot initiative (referendum) you are voting on and write “yes” or “no.”
